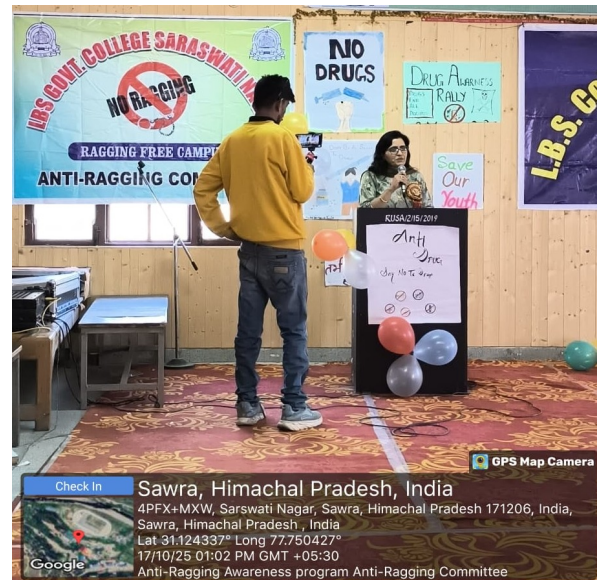
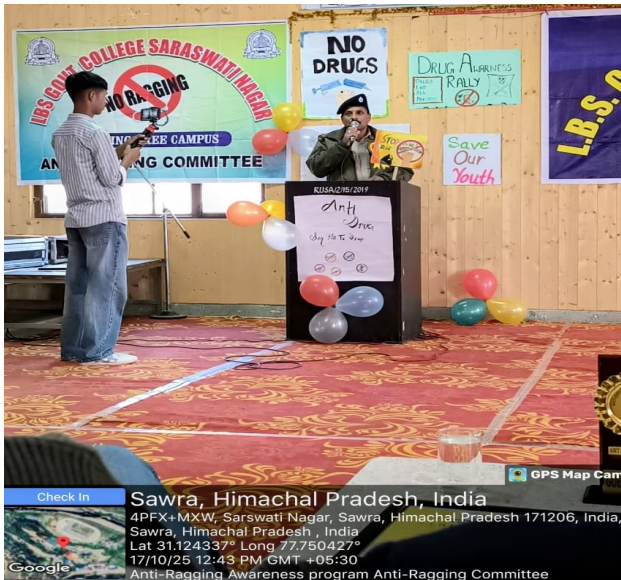


Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme
