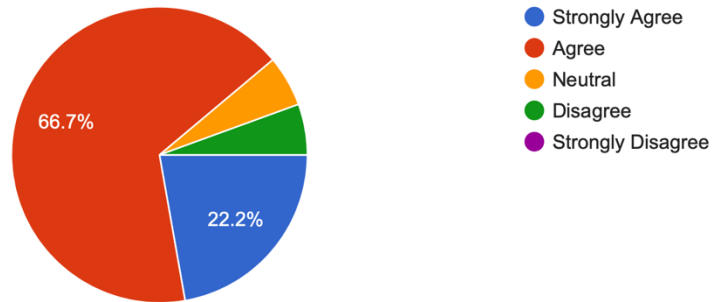

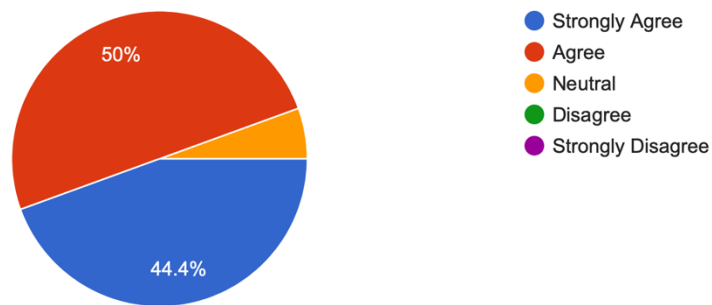
1. Curriculum and Syllabus are need based.

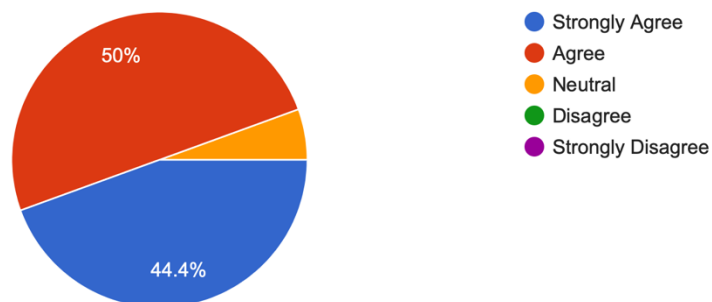
2. The course outcomes are well defined and clear.

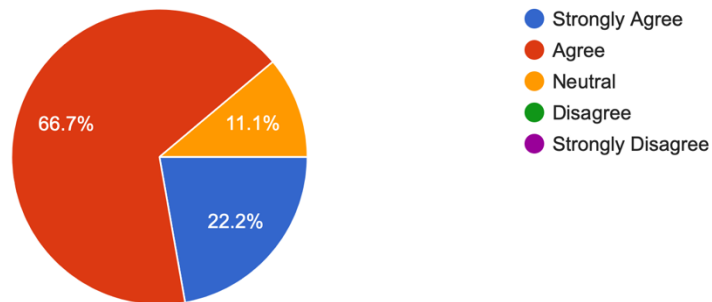
3. Sufficient number of relevant reading materials and digital resources are available in the College.

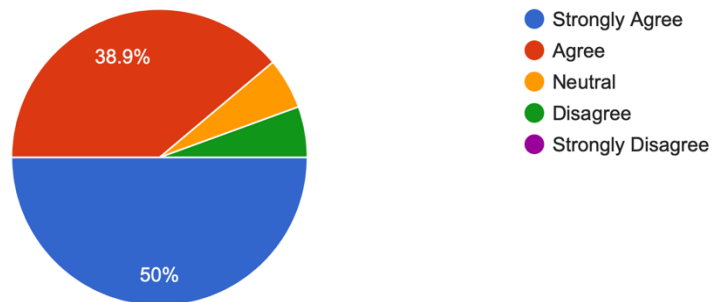
4. The course has good balance between theory and application.

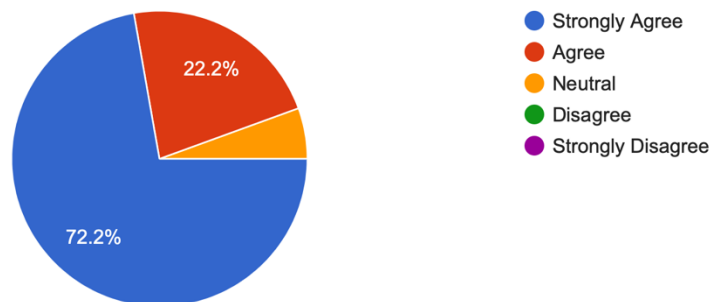
5. The course/syllabus of this course increased my knowledge and perspective in the subject area.

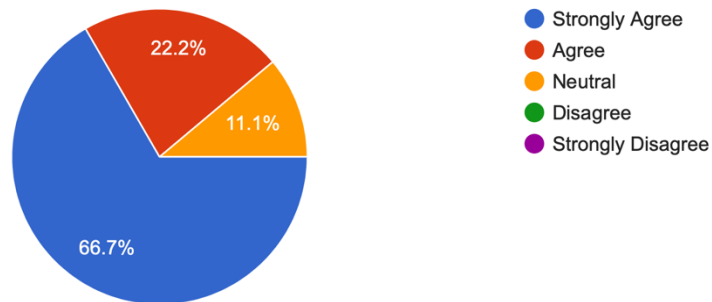

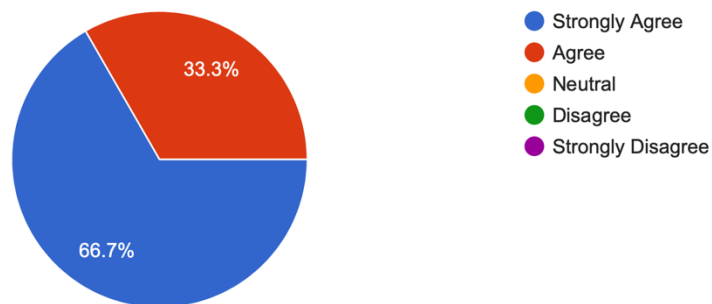

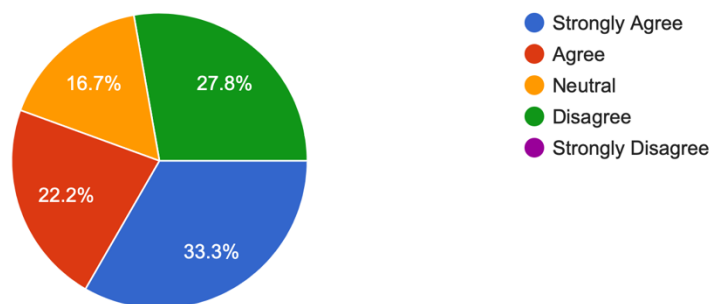
