‘Women Grievance/ Sexual Harassment & Redressal Cell’ of the college organized an **introductory program** with the girls on 04th October 2021 in the college hall at 1:00 pm. Around 163 girls were present during this program. The Convener of the Women Cell, Dr Poonam Mehta welcomed all the girls in the new session and introduced all the girls with the members of the Women Cell. She briefed the students with the aims and objectives of the Women Cell in the college. Dr Lalita Rawat, Vice Principal of the College was invited to interact with the girls and to aware the girls about health, hygiene, sanitation, nutrition, sexual harassment or other abuses and their legal rights. She put light on Vishakha Guidelines which were instituted by Supreme Court of India in the Year 1997. These guidelines are a set of guidelines that were intended to protect women at workplace. She also talked about some women helpline numbers like 1091 which can help the girls during odd or unfavourable situations. After this, students were asked to give their names for the President and Vice President of the Women Cell for the active functioning of the cell. Later, the meeting was kept open for all the girls to share their views/problems/queries. Girls actively participated and asked various questions regarding their health and sanitation. At the end of the program, Dr Poonam Mehta thanked the speaker of the day, Dr Lalita Rawat, members of the women cell and all the girls present during the program.
