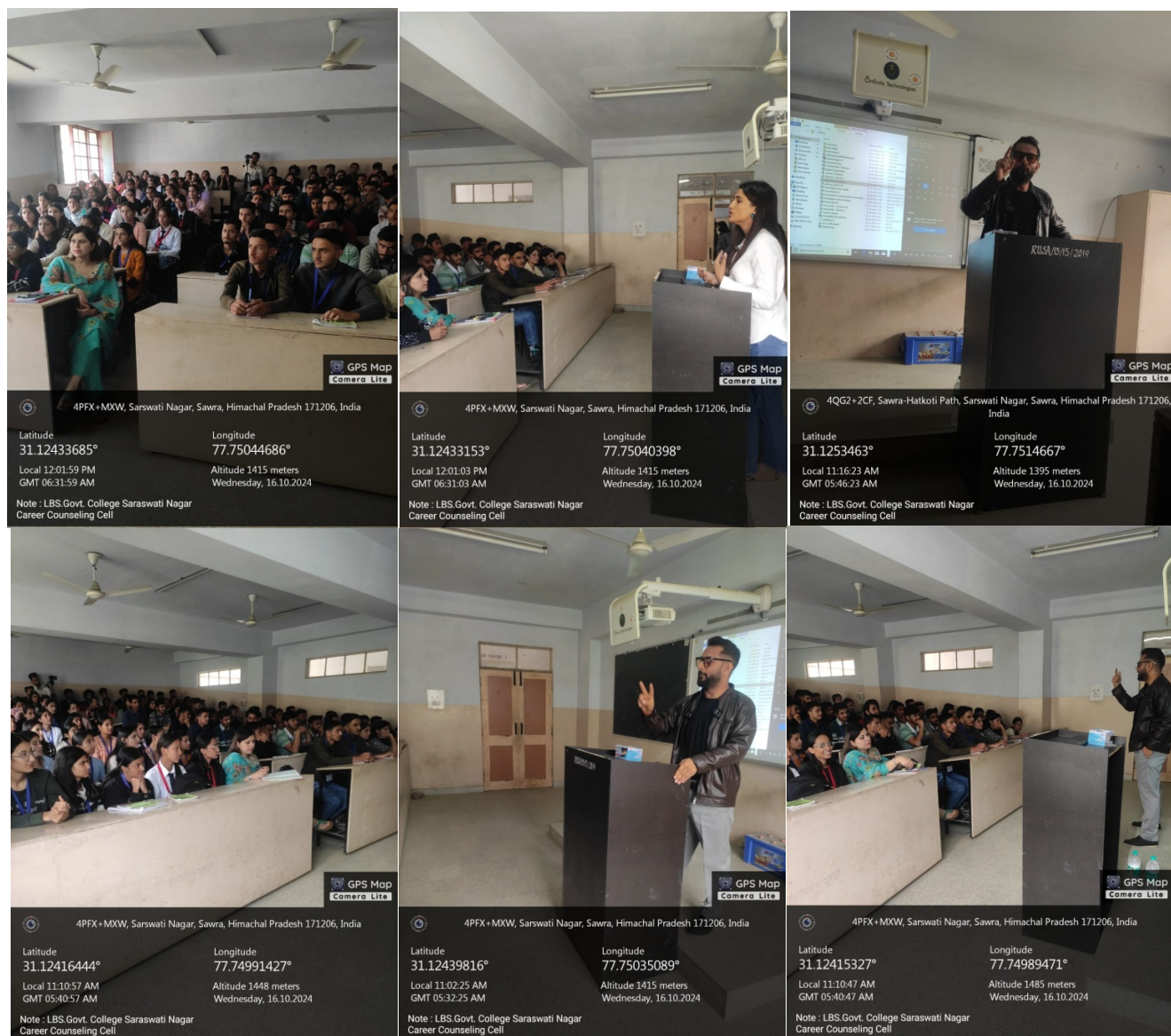

1. LECTURE BY MR BACHAN SINGH ON PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT & SELF CONFIDENCE (16.10.2024)

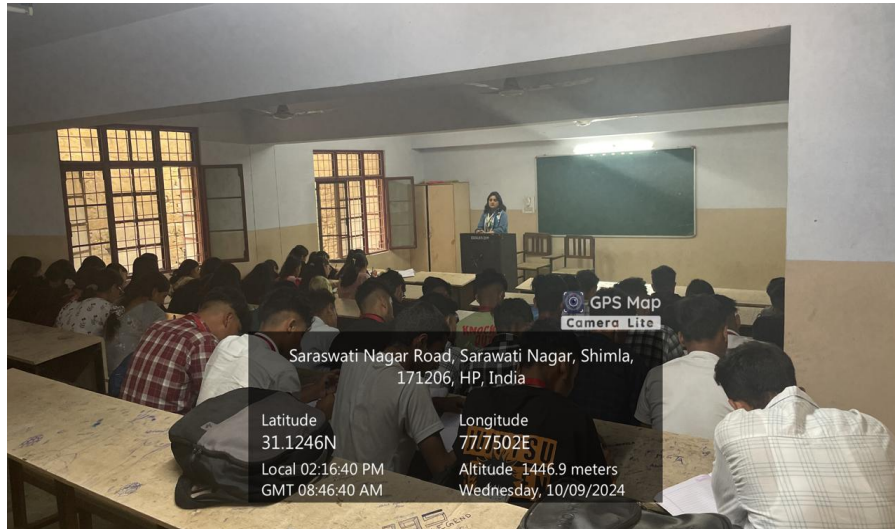

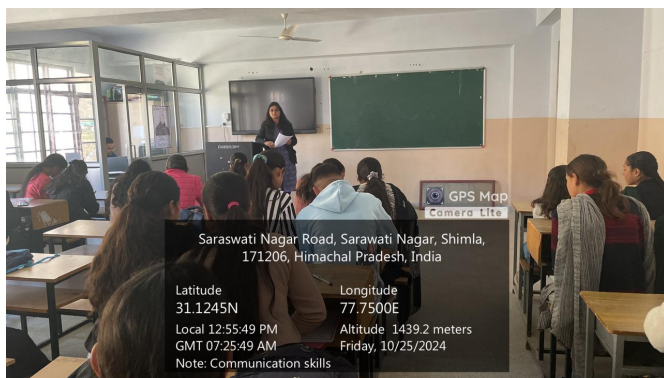

3. WORKSHOP CUM CAREER COUNSELLING SESSION OF BSC FINAL YEAR STUDENTS AT GOVT PG COLLEGE SEEMA (NAAC CLUSTER COLLEGE) (07.11.2024)

BSc Final Year Students (08) along with the Faculty members Dr Punam Chauhan, Dept of Zoology and Dr Radha Raman Gautam, Dept of Physics of LBS Govt College attended a Workshop cum Career Counseling Session at Govt PG College Seema. This workshop cum career counseling session for the BSc 3rd Year students of both colleges was organised by Dr Umesh Narta, HOD, Dept of Botany, Govt PG College Seema which is amongst the NAAC Cluster College with us. The workshop and career counseling session was conducted by Prof Sudhir Sayal, HOD, Dept of Biotechnology & Bioinformatics and Ms Sandhya Tegta, Research Scholar from Jaypee University of Information Technology (JUIT) Wagnaghat. After the workshop, career counseling session was conducted by Prof Sudhir Sayal and guided students about various career option and institutes from where they can pursue the future education after their graduation. He also delivered a lecture on 'How to Learn Better' to students and 'Innovative Skills in Teaching' to all the faculty members.

Students got hands on experience of various molecular biology based experiments like Separation and Visualization of PCR based DNA, KOH String Analysis for the identification of Gram +ve & Gram -ve Bacteria, Catalase Test for identification of Aerobic & Anaerobic Bacteria and many other molecular biology experiments. The session ended up with great enthusiasm among the students and they were found very motivated for their career and future life.

1. KOH String Test: Students were able to distinguish between Gram +ve & Gram -ve Bacteria by using KOH as when KOH is added to Gram -ve bacteria, KOH (alkaline) dissolves the lipid cell wall of this bacteria and due to which nuclear material comes out and it becomes viscous, therefore, a string is formed in this solution by using toothpick. But in Gram +ve bacteria string cannot be formed as KOH will not be able to dissolve the thick peptidoglycan cell wall.

2. Catalase Test: Students also were able to identify aerobic and anaerobic bacteria by using H_2O_2 . As in a slide both aerobic and anaerobic bacteria inoculums are taken separately and then H_2O_2 is added in both, if bubbles of O_2 will appear it means the inoculum is of aerobic bacteria and if not then it is anaerobic bacteria. As aerobic bacteria has catalase enzyme which converts H_2O_2 into H_2O and O_2 but catalase enzyme is absent in anaerobic bacteria.

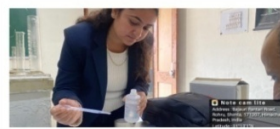
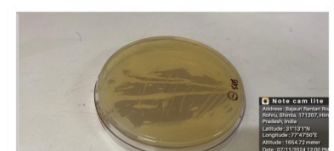
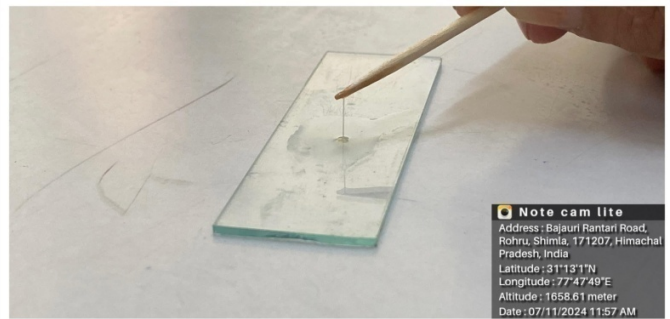
3. PCR: Students also extracted DNA from eukaryotic bacteria and observed it through PCR.
