Day 1: Visit to Bhimakali Mata Temple, Sarahan (19th November 2025)

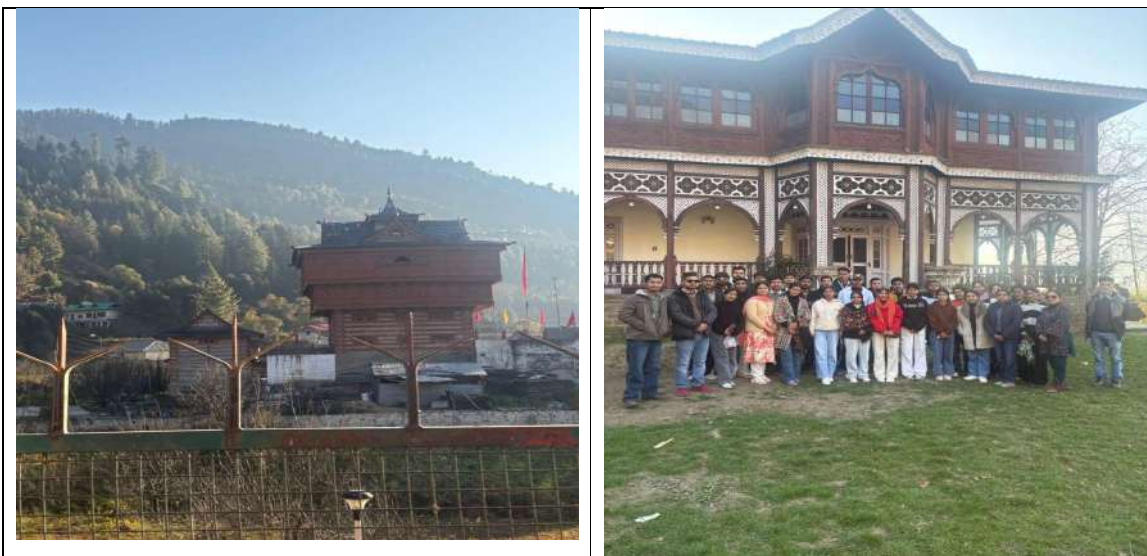
