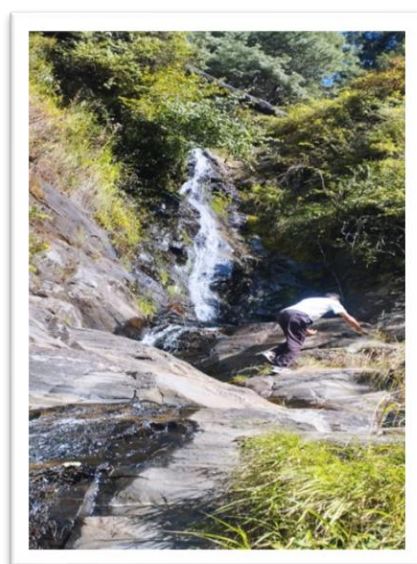


ALL INDIA TRACKING CAMP (HIM TRECK III) 2024

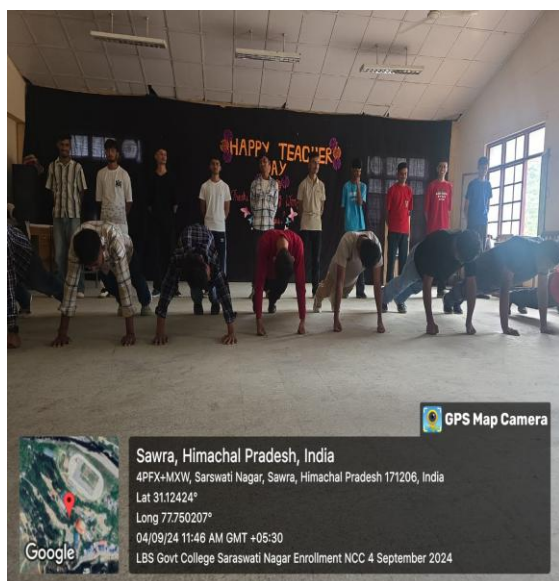
EBSB-II
