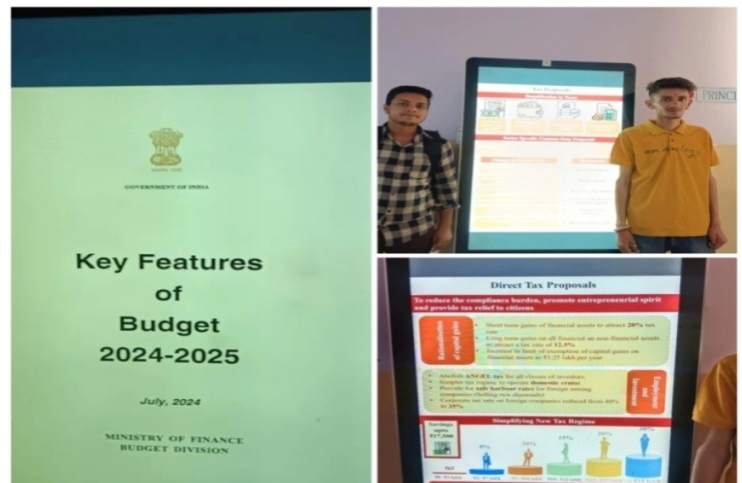


Budget 2024-25 Highlights on Smart display board
