The meeting was presided over by the In-charge of the YTC, who addressed the students on the growing relevance of tourism in today's world. He explained how tourism promotes cultural exchange, supports local economies, and enhances students' understanding of heritage, environment, and diverse traditions.

Following this, Dr. Sandeep Thakur, Assistant Professor of Commerce in the college, also shared his views on the tourism destination in Himachal Pradesh. He highlighted the need for responsible and sustainable tourism, encouraging students to explore destinations with sensitivity towards local communities and ecological balance. He motivated the members to participate actively in tourism-related programmes to broaden their practical knowledge.

The second part of the meeting focused on selecting a destination for the Club's forthcoming educational tour. Several places were discussed, keeping in mind accessibility, educational value, and the interest of students. After thoughtful deliberation, the House unanimously decided to organize a tour to Rampur-Bushahr, MaaBhimakali Temple at Sarahan in District Shimla and BagaSarahan in District Kullu. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks, expressing appreciation for the active participation of students and encouraging them to contribute wholeheartedly to the activities of the Yuva Tourism Club.



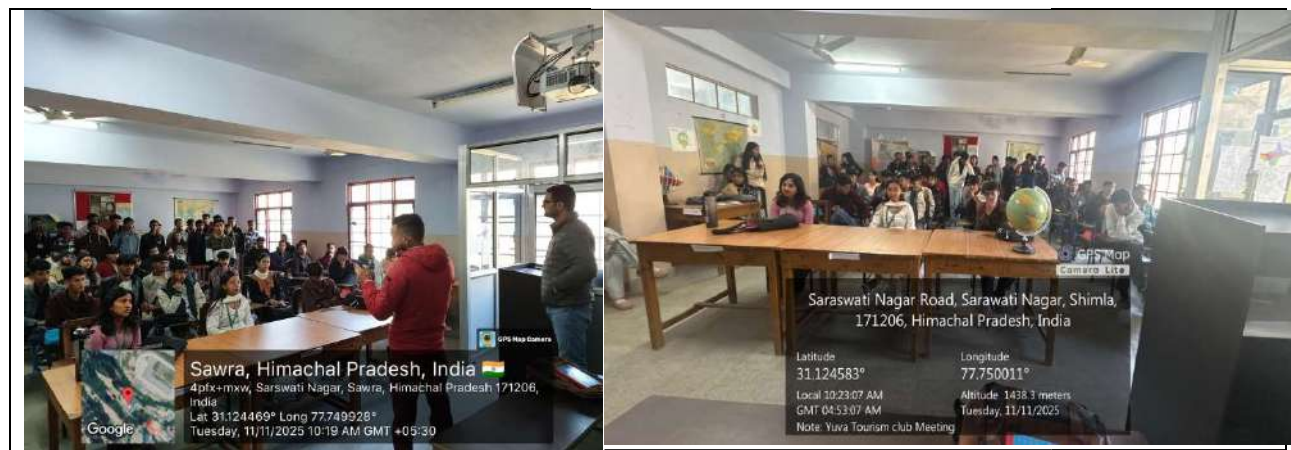
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Tourism Tour Organised by Yuva Tourism Club

1. Introduction

The **Yuva Tourism Club of LBS Government College Saraswati Nagar** organised a two-day tourism tour on **19th and 20th November 2025** for participating students. The purpose of the tour was to explore the cultural heritage, natural landscape, biodiversity, and tourism potential of selected destinations in **Shimla** and **Kullu** districts. The tour covered two major sites: the **Bhimakali Mata Temple in Sarahan (Shimla District)** and the scenic tourism destination of **BagaSarahan (Kullu District)**.

The tour was organised with the following objectives:

- To promote awareness about **local tourism resources** among students.
- To expose students to the **cultural, historical, and architectural heritage** of Himachal Pradesh.
- To understand the **natural landscape, biodiversity, and tourism significance** of Himalayan destinations.
- To encourage responsible tourism practices and respect for cultural sites.
- To provide experiential learning through field visits, observation, and interaction.

Day 1: Visit to Bhimakali Mata Temple, Sarahan (19th November 2025)



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The tour commenced on the morning of **19th November** with a visit to the renowned **Bhimakali Mata Temple**, an ancient and culturally significant Shakti Peeth located in Sarahan, Shimla District.

Major highlights included:

- Observation of the **traditional Kath-Kuni architectural style** of the temple complex.
- Learning about the **religious importance, historical background**, and cultural practices associated with the shrine.
- Understanding the **settlement pattern, elevation, and natural surroundings** of Sarahan town.
- Interaction with local visitors and shopkeepers to understand tourism flow in the region.

Students experienced the cultural richness of Himachal Pradesh and gained insights into heritage tourism.





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Day 2: Visit to NirmandBagaSarahan (20th November 2025)

On **20th November**, the team proceeded to **BagaSarahan**, a beautiful high-altitude meadow and emerging tourist destination situated in Kullu District.

Key learning aspects included:

- Studying the **natural landscape**, including lush meadows, alpine forests, streams, and mountain slopes.
- Observing the region's **biodiversity, vegetation patterns, and ecosystem characteristics**.
- Understanding the tourism potential of BagaSarahan in **eco-tourism and adventure tourism**.
- Learning about the environmental sensitivity of the region and the need for **sustainable tourism**.

Students also engaged in photography, note-taking, and field sketching for documentation.



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Report on Mass Awareness Rally on 38th World AIDS Day

The **Red Ribbon Club** of the college organised a **Mass Awareness Rally** on the occasion of the **38th World AIDS Day** on **29th November 2025 (Saturday)**. The rally was conducted under

- Promoted the theme of transforming the AIDS response in today's changing global environment.



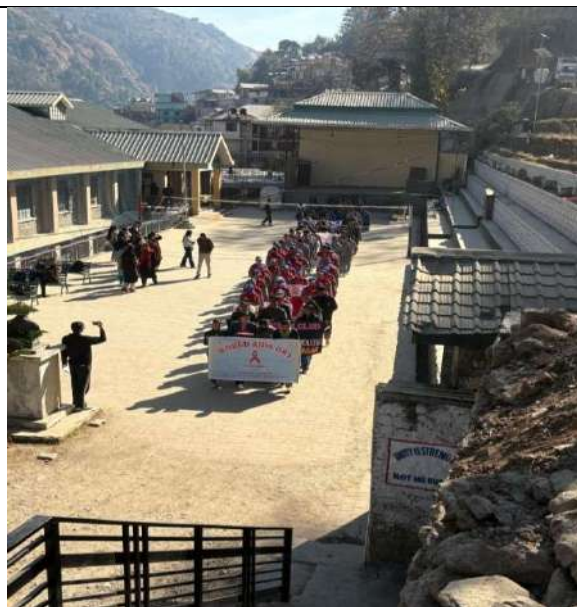
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
