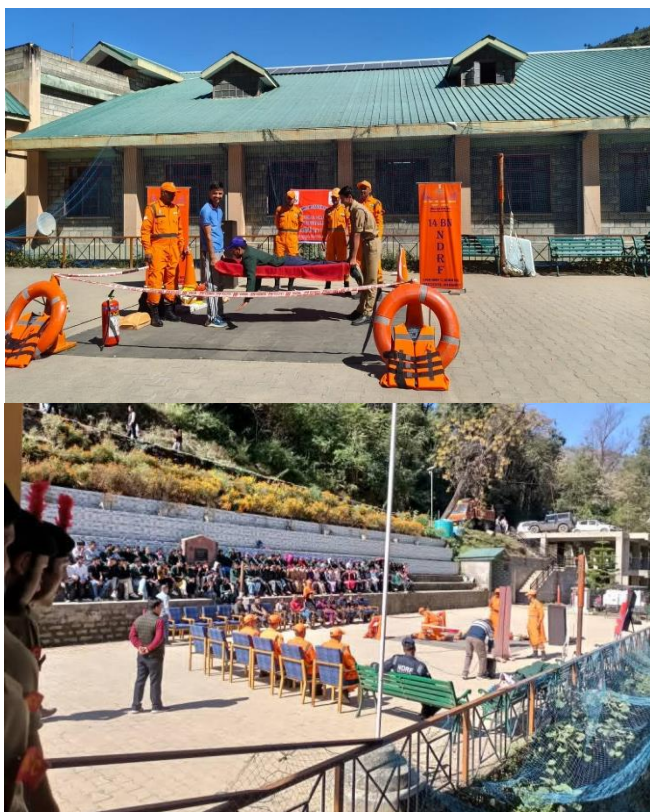
**MoU between LBS Govt. College and Pratibha Spandan with RVS Govt. College Seema signed with agenda:**

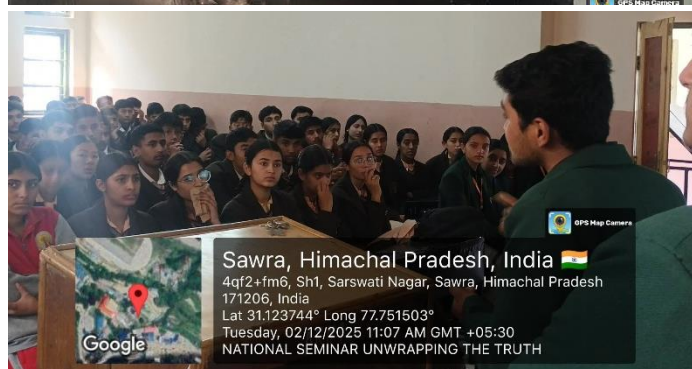

## National Seminar against the Package Food Items

2<sup>nd</sup> Dec 2025



A one-day NATIONAL SEMINAR-cum-CAMPAIGN against the package food items entitled, ‘UNWRAPPING THE TRUTH’ was organised by Lal Bahadur Shastri Govt. Degree College, Saraswati Nagar in collaboration with Global Indian Scientists & Technocrats” forum (GIST) and Aahaar Kranti, a public movement launched by organisation’s like Vijnana Bharati and the GIST Forum to raise awareness about nutritional balance and the importance of local, accessible
