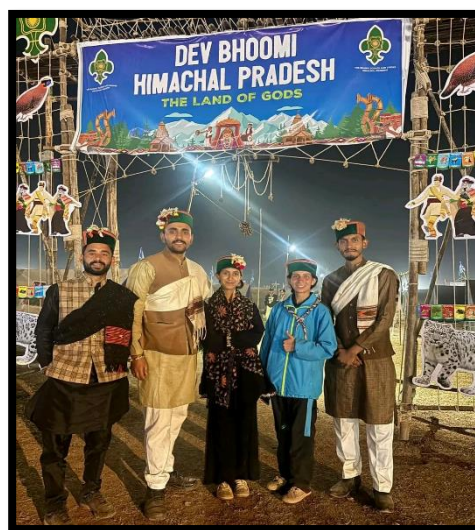

26 Jan 2026

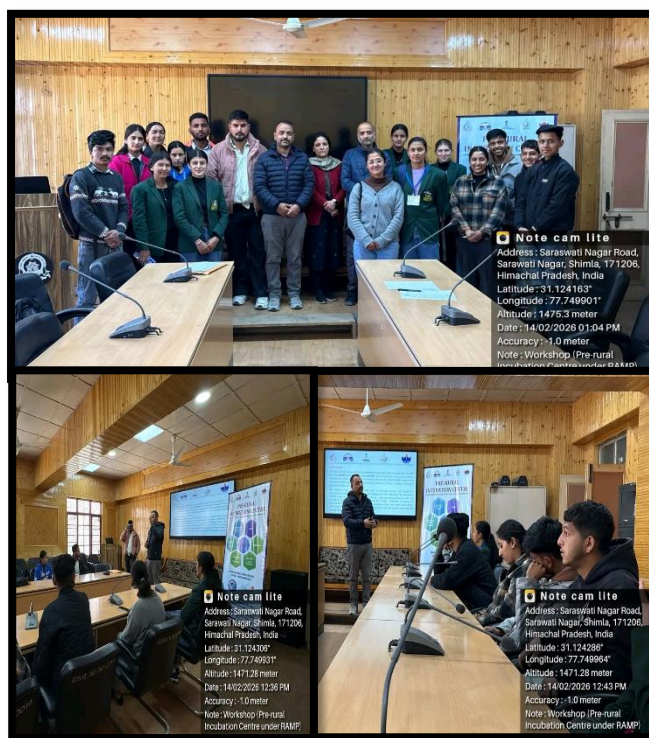
