04th April 2026

A Mock Drill on Earthquake was conducted on 4th April 2026 by Asst. Prof. Kailash Chauhan, Department of Geography, in our institution following the recent earthquake tremors felt in

Himachal Pradesh. The main objective of this drill was to create awareness among students and staff about safety measures to be followed

during an earthquake and to prepare them for emergency situations. During the drill, students were guided to follow the “Drop, Cover, and Hold” technique and were later evacuated safely to the designated assembly area in a disciplined manner.
