L.B.S Govt. Degree College now P.G. college was established in July 1986 to cater to the higher educational needs of the people of this area. The opening of the college in such a hard area marked the beginning of a new intellectual climate in the entire region. Since then this college has been providing various opportunities for the youth of this area and has been enabling them to acquire skills and confidence to face the world. #### **RUSA Grant**

Under RUSA 2. a sum of Rs. 2, 00,000,000-(Two Crore only) grant was sanctioned to this college and 1<sup>st</sup> installment of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Crore) was received from RUSA under" RUSA Infrastructure Grant" for the Infrastructure Development of the College. Out of this an amount Rs. 93, 64,540/- has been utilized for creation of various facilities like Gymnasium, Digital Teaching Devices, up-gradation of class rooms and campus beautification.

# Library

The college has a voluminous and spacious Library which caters to the educational and recreational needs of both students and the staff. It has about 11,627 books on different subjects. It subscribes to 6 newspapers and 18 periodicals to facilitate the students and staff members. The college is also member of Inflibnet Ahmedabad. 358 new books were added during the session with more emphasis on competitive books. Library was equipped with new seating infrastructure during the current year.
